Local rules

1. Out of bounds is defined by fences around the course and white stakes.
2. If a ball strikes an elevated power line, the stroke must be canceled and replayed, without penalty (rule 20-5). If the ball is not immediately recoverable, another ball may be substituted.
3. Distance markers and stakes that define ground under repair are immovable obstructions (rule 24-2).
 - Distance markers are yellow with black tops.
 - Blue stakes and blue lines mark ground under repair, from which play is allowed (rule 25-1).
 - Blue stakes with white tops mark ground under repair from which play is prohibited. If a player's ball lies in the area the player must take relief under rule 25-1.
4. Stones and shells in bunkers are movable obstructions (rule 24-1).
5. Players may only take relief under rule 25-1b from areas that are marked with blue lines if their ball is within the area. Interference by the player's stance is deemed not to be, of itself, interference under Rule 25-1.
6. Blue and red stakes to the right of the 15th hole are used to help players position their shot and are immovable obstructions.
7. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
8. The penalty for breach of local rules is 2 strokes.
