## **MAXIMILIAN ROTLUFF AND HEIDI BAEK DECLARED CHAMPIONS OF THE SECOND ANNUAL UNITED STATES JUNIOR MASTERS**

December 22, 2010 - Ponte Vedra, FL – Maximilian Rotluff of Germany won the Boys Division of the U.S. Junior Masters today shooting a 1 under par 71 at the famed TPC Sawgrass Stadium Course. The tournament also comprised two days of preliminary play on the TPC Valley Course. Rotluff's scores over the three days were a consistent below par 71-71-71. Andreas Halversen of Norway claimed second place with scores of 73-74-77 and Frederick Hansen Jullum of Norway took third with scores of 70-81-74.

In the Girl's Division, Heidi Baek of England claimed her victory after a stunning 15 feet putt on the 18<sup>th</sup> green during a playoff against Megan Khang of the U.S. Baek's three day scores were 75-75-78, followed by Khang's 75-74-79. In third place for the ladies was Nicole Broch Larsen of Denmark with a 76-77-77.

The United States Junior Masters is the final tournament in the World Junior Golf Series Tour for 2010. The Tour will resume in 2011 in March in South Africa; followed by Poland and Iceland in June; Germany in August; then returning to the United States next December.

The United States Junior Masters is an international golf competition that fosters enhanced performance, sportsmanship, and camaraderie showcasing premiere junior golfers worldwide. The World Junior Golf Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation dedicated to creating a competitive international arena for youth that will promote good citizenship, scholarship, benevolence, competitive spirit and outstanding ethical conduct through a variety of competitive sports activities and other organized learning experiences.
