

## **Explanation of points:**

Points will be awarded at every stroke play event the World Junior Golf Series conducts. The top ten finishers in the boys and girls at each tournament will accumulate points. The points race will begin in June at the Icelandic Junior Masters will end at the United States Junior Masters in December 2009. Here is how the point's structure will work:

<b>1<sup>st</sup> Place - 1000 Points</b>	<b>6<sup>th</sup> Place - 300 Points</b>
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> Place - 700 Points</b>	<b>7<sup>th</sup> Place - 250 Points</b>
<b>3<sup>rd</sup> Place - 550 Points</b>	<b>8<sup>th</sup> Place - 200 Points</b>
<b>4<sup>th</sup> Place - 400 Points</b>	<b>9<sup>th</sup> Place - 150 Points</b>
<b>5<sup>th</sup> Place - 350 Points</b>	<b>10<sup>th</sup> Place - 100 Points</b>

### **Ties**

If there are ties for a specific place, the points will be split evenly. For example, a three player tie for 3<sup>rd</sup> place would result in each player receiving 433 points (1300 total points for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> divided evenly among three players).
